Policy Statement

Footloose Performing Arts Ltd is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of all children and young people and expects all staff, teachers and volunteers to share this commitment.

Key principles:

- The welfare of the child is paramount
- All children have the right to protection from harm
- All concerns will be taken seriously
- Staff must report concerns immediately
- Appropriate recruitment and DBS procedures will be followed

Reporting Concerns

Any safeguarding concern involving a child must be reported immediately to the Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL).

Staff Conduct

- Never communicate privately with children through personal social media
- Avoid one-to-one situations where possible
- Treat all students equally and respectfully
- Report concerns immediately
